## LCUMC Membership Class

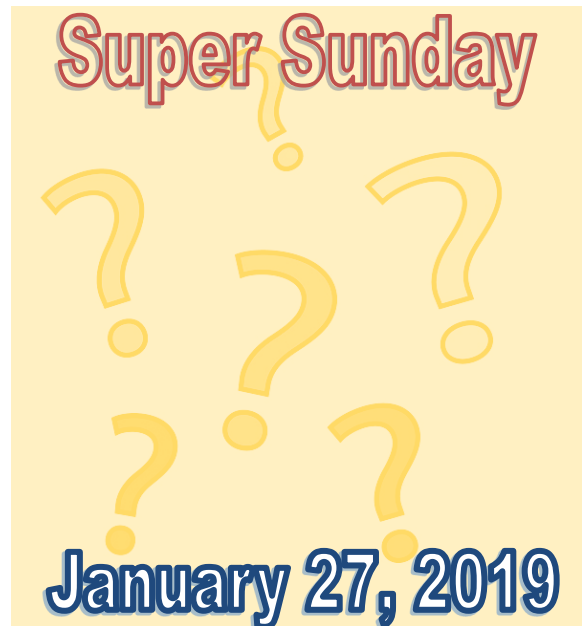

**Name** My name is Paul Matthew Peschel

**Where is home?** My home is on a beautiful piece of meadow and woods just south of Leland.

**What part do you sing in choir** I have sung every part in choirs, from being a boy soprano to my current bass/baritone range.

### **How long have you been singing in choirs? How long have you been singing in the LCUMC choir?**

There isn't a church memory that doesn't include choral singing. It began with St. Martin's Episcopal children/youth choir. Then came the Cathedral church of St. Paul in downtown Detroit as a boy soprano. During that time I was invited to audition for and became part of the inaugural and subsequent (summer) seasons of the Berkshire Boy Choir which was based in Tanglewood, Massachusetts. We were invited to the Tanglewood music festival, the Saratoga NY music festival, the Lincoln Center music festival and other east coast venues. Locally I have been involved with the Immanuel Lutheran choir and here at LCUMC. I have been with the choir here since 2001.

### **Is there a hymn or anthem that has a special place in your heart?**

One of my most memorable pieces of music was my first solo at St. Paul's. Felix Mendelssohn's "Hear my prayer, oh God incline thine ear".

### **Can you give me a few words that describe the choir to you?**

The choir is a supportive place of connection and commitment. It is a place where I can share my love for God through sacred choral music.
